Employment Programs

Radius employment programs help individuals connect to the world of work. Programs can include:

- Personal Development Workshops: communications, decision making, work-life balance
- Workplace certificates (First Aid, WHMIS, Safe Food Handling, etc.)
- GED 12 Preparation
- Business writing, math skills, computer familiarization
- Assessments to determine career direction
- Career Portfolios: resumes, interview tools
- Community and worksite experience

Business Projects / Partnerships

In **Workplace Workshops** our adult educators stylize activities to target employee development needs. These can include such topics as:

- Discovering your strengths
- Workplace Essential Skills Improvement
- Values and Goals – Achieving that Work-Life Balance

Past projects include work with the following: Vecima Networks, WinnBay Sand Ltd., Dumont Technical Institute and Saskatchewan Indian Institute of Technology Saskatoon and Northern programs.

Community Involvement

Radius is involved in the community with such groups as the Saskatoon Literacy Coalition, the FASD Interagency Committee, Benchmarks of Adult Education Advisory Committee and the Saskatchewan Industry Education Council.

Community Integration Services

In the **Acquired Brain Injury (ABI)** and **Youth Companion Program (YCP)**, support is given for families with children and youth with cognitive disabilities. These services provide families with access to a support worker for recreation and social activities for their child/youth. The child/youth have fun and the families are better able to balance work-life demands. Activities for these programs operate evenings, weekends and during the summer.

In **Sports for Life**, adults (18yr-30yr) with an Acquired Brain Injury can participate in inclusive weekly recreation activities to promote overall health and wellness.
